In March of 2010, GAHF opened the first National German-American Heritage Museum of the USA as the cultural institution for German-American heritage and culture. Located in a former residential townhouse built by German immigrant and merchant John Hockemeyer, the Victorian structure is part of the Penn Quarter, a historic settlement of Germans in Washington, DC.
